Domestic

There were good numbers across all domestic airlines, with the major increases recorded on the trunk routes of Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne. Melbourne was the strongest with a 22% increase compared to April 2016, while Brisbane and Sydney were 12% and 13% higher respectively.

The total number of flights on these routes increased by 6%. Some of the increase in domestic passenger numbers was due to the timing of the Easter holidays and disruption in other parts of Queensland due to the impacts of Cyclone Debbie. Qantas's daily flights to Hamilton Island from Cairns have resumed after being suspended between March 26th and April 12th.

International

There was steady growth across all the direct international flights on the network with the Japan routes continuing to perform well, following a record month in March.


