### 1 million passengers in 2 months

For the first time, over one million passengers used the airport in a two month period. This milestone coincides with the airports busiest months in the year which are July in T2 Domestic and August in T1 International.

### Domestic

Domestic passengers increased 2.4% compared to the previous year. Combined passengers on Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne routes increased by 15,300 (+2.5%) which offset declines on jet-operated routes to other interstate cities. Passengers on Queensland regional routes flown by turboprops increased 3.3%.

### International

Cairns-Bali passengers increased by 45% to 5,600 passengers. The passenger growth was higher than the 30% increase in seats from the addition of Jetstar's fourth weekly service. It is a popular route for the 253,000 European visitors who visit Cairns each year.

Hainan Airlines announced twice weekly flights between Shenzhen and Cairns from December 2017, adding a second mainland Chinese gateway to Cairns.

China Eastern announced a seasonal service for Chinese New Year, with three flights per week planned through February 2018.

All new flights are subject to government approval.

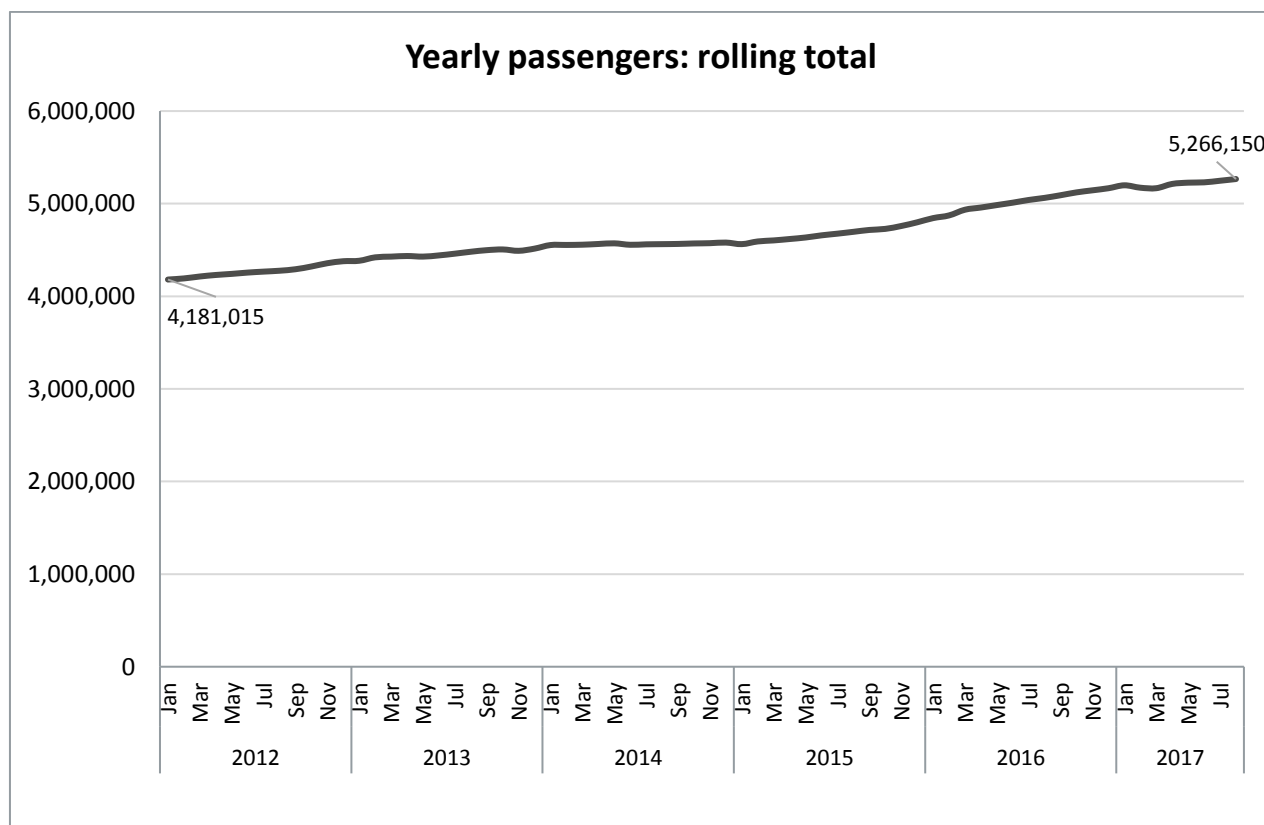
