21% international growth

Chinese New Year passengers were the main contributor to the strong international growth for February. Passengers on Cairns' China and Hong Kong flights increased 143% compared to last year. Cairns routes to Japan continue to be our largest and they increased 16%.

9% domestic growth

Most of the domestic growth came from increases on Sydney (+8,700 passengers, +11%) and Brisbane (+8,600 passengers, +9%). Sydney is a popular route for international visitors while Brisbane has high rates of local and business travellers.

Annual passengers exceed 5.3million for the first time

In the past five years, passengers flying to and from Cairns have increased by nearly 1 million. On a daily basis, this averages nearly 500 more passengers each day.

Increased domestic flights and new international flights being flown by larger aircraft with fewer empty seats are key contributors to the growth.


