## **Domestic**

Domestic passengers increased 2.7% compared to the previous year. This was due to an additional 10,000 passengers (+3.2%) travelling on the combined Brisbane, Sydney and Melbourne routes. A total of 325,000 passengers flew on these three routes in July.

All other routes were stable with a 0.3% passenger increase.

## International

The largest contributor to July's international growth were passengers flying on the Tokyo and Osaka routes. They increased 16% to 22,800. The large increase was on the back of a 23% schedule increase, with a total of 101 flights being operated compared to 82 flights last July.

SilkAir passengers increased 48% to 5,900. This was a positive response to the introduction of their seasonal fifth weekly flight to Singapore. The fifth weekly flight will become year round from November.

Philippine Airlines announced the launch of non-stop flights between Manila and Auckland, starting December 6<sup>th</sup> 2017. This will result in the suspension of the Manila-Cairns-Auckland flights.


