Domestic

June passenger numbers were slightly lower due to the 2017 school holidays starting one week later than 2016 in Queensland and New South Wales.

Passengers on non-stop routes from the state capitals and the Gold Coast to Cairns were down 2,540 (-0.9%) to 281,000. These seven routes account for 87% of Cairns domestic passengers and are busiest during the mid-year school holidays.

Cairns regional routes grew again in June. This is due to factors such as mine development in Cape York and more international travellers visiting central Australia. The regional route growth was 1,550 passengers (+3.4%). Additionally, there was 6% growth of transfer passengers connecting to/from regional flights in Cairns.

International

The largest contributor to June's growth were passengers flying on the Tokyo and Osaka routes which increased 19% to 20,500. This was notable because June is traditionally a quiet month on the Japan routes.

China Southern announced they will commence year-round flying between Guangzhou and Cairns with the first flight landing in Cairns on Thursday, December 14th. The schedule will be three per week as follows:

Cairns-Guangzhou

Guangzhou's airport code CAN comes from the time when the city's English language name was Canton.

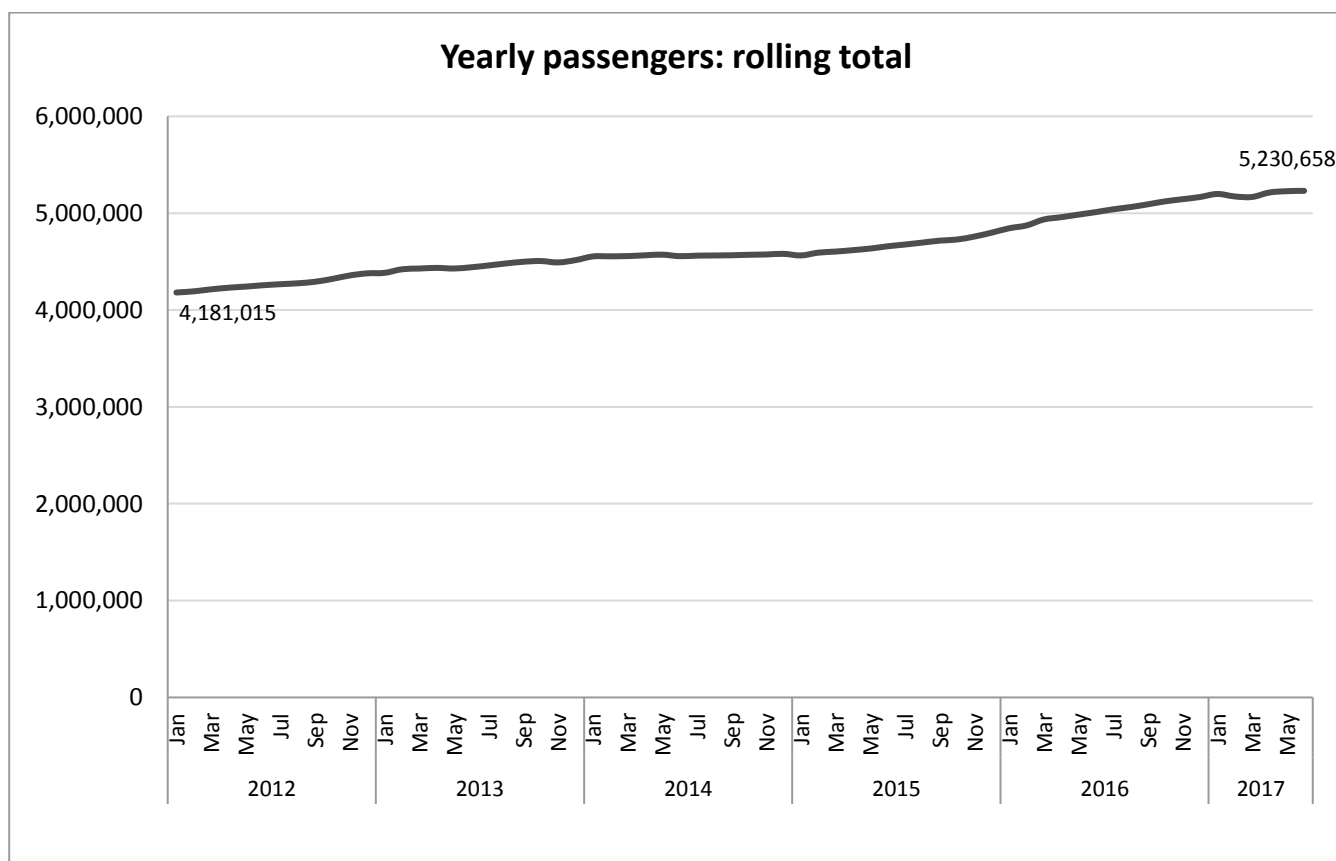
