## Domestic

May is traditionally one of the quieter months for Cairns, but domestic growth continued. Passengers on the main routes of Brisbane, Melbourne and Sydney increased 4,100 (1.8%) to 238,100.

Another growth area was regional flying on Air North, Alliance, Qantas Link, Regional Express (Rex) and Skytrans. Combined, passengers on these routes increased 3,000 (9%) to 36,200.

## International

3,800 passengers flew on Hong Kong Airlines, a 164% increase on May 2016. Hong Kong is a key hub in the Greater China aviation market and the Hong Kong Airlines services are proving popular with Chinese travellers.

Passengers on the Cairns-Bali flights increased 47% to 5,800. Firstly, this year there were four flights per week compared to three per week this year. Secondly, there were more passengers per flight. The Bali flights are being used by North Queensland residents and European travellers who are making a stopover.


