

APPLICATION / APPROVAL TO CONDUCT HOT WORKS

HOT WORK Permit No: [REDACTED]-19

Applicable to all operations involving flame, hot air or arc welding and cutting/grinding equipment, brazing and soldering equipment, blowlamps, bitumen boilers and other equipment producing heat or having naked flames.

Hot Work is NOT permitted unless this form is completed and signed by Cairns Airport Authorising Officer.

Conditions:

1. All Hot Works will be shrouded / screened, with measures taken to ensure other stakeholders or the general public are not affected.
 2. Applicant hereby indemnifies CAIRNS AIRPORT against any damage, person or property, as a result of undertaking Hot Work.
 3. Apron Co-ordinators to be advised of works and isolations as appropriate. (Tel: 4080 6744)
 4. Permit is only valid for the period stated below.
 5. Full compliance with all applicable legislation including:
 - a. Work Health and Safety Act & Regulation 2011
 - b. Civil Aviation Order (CAO) 20.9 Stipulates a 15m risk zone from aircraft and refuelling equipment.

 - c. AS 1674.1 (Permit maximum duration = 8 hours if work is in a "Hazardous Area")
 6. Hot Worker must abide to the directions of the Authorising Officer.
 7. Fire panel, smoke/thermal detectors and other systems to be isolated as appropriate. Minimum 48 hours' notice is required.
 8. Remove or protect all combustible materials within the work zone.
 9. Portable fire extinguisher supplied by the contractor/workgroup are to be located immediately adjacent to the hot work area and within 10m.
 10. Any work / hot work in the vicinity of the JUHI Fuel Line will require a separate permit / approval from JUHI. Contact Gary Ingram on Tel: 4046 2302 or 0413 765108 prior to ANY work commencing.
 11. Contractor to attach hereto a Risk Assessment and Safe Work Method Statement detailing safe work practices, precautions taken, fire-fighting equipment available or supplied and any other relevant safety information.
 12. A copy of the permit is to be held at the actual work location and must be produced if requested by the CAIRNS AIRPORT Project Officer and/or CAIRNS AIRPORT Authorised Officer
 13. Cairns Airport Reserves the right to withdraw this approval at any time without notice.
 14. **EMERGENCY CONTACT – In the event of a Fire, contact Apron Coordinators IMMEDIATELY on Tel: 4080 6744 or activate nearest Manual Call Point.**
 15. Work area and all adjacent areas to which sparks and heat might have spread are to be thoroughly inspected on completion of the operation, and a **continuous thirty minute** vigil at the work area maintained after the work was completed.
 16. Apron Co-ordinators to be advised on completion of works, including confirmation that the work area is safe for normal operation and stakeholder use and that all systems have been de-isolated.
