

Environment Policy

Our airports are surrounded by diverse coastal forests and mangrove wetlands that link the land with the Great Barrier Reef. Our natural environment is one of our region's greatest assets and we want to operate airports that our people, visitors, and local communities can be proud of.

This policy is our commitment to the protection of environmental values and provides a framework for setting environmental objectives. The purpose of this policy is to guide us to deliver this commitment in alignment with our Land Use Plan. This Policy will be maintained as documented information, communicated within the organisation, and made available to interested parties.

We will:

- Demonstrate leadership and promote the commitment to sustainable environmental management to all stakeholders including employees, tenants, adjacent landholders and the community;
- Comply with relevant environmental legislation and strive for best practice;
- Identify priority environmental issues across our business by working collaboratively with stakeholders;
- Set progressive environmental objectives and targets, provide adequate resources to implement the processes needed to meet these targets, and track our performance against them;
- Take action on climate adaption to continually improve our resilience and to reduce our contribution to greenhouse gas emissions;
- Manage day-to-day operations and emergency situations to prevent pollution, protect local biodiversity and ecosystems, and reduce environmental nuisance including noise and light pollution;
- Manage resources sustainably, including energy and water, and minimise our waste footprint;
- Take action to enhance priority habitats on airport landholdings to better support flora and fauna, including threatened species;
- Contribute to research and pilot projects required to propel environmental understanding and drive positive change in our region;
- Provide targeted environmental training to our people, contractors and relevant stakeholders
- Report on performance; and
- Continually improve the effectiveness of our Environmental Management System to enhance our environmental performance and manage our risks.
